Toronto City By-law 349-11 states that dogs must always be on a leash "except as permitted in those areas of City parks where dogs are permitted to run at large as designated by City by-law". Do not to allow your pets to do their business by the front door planters, on the exclusive use terrace areas or in any common areas.

1. Garbage must be thrown down the chute and not left on the chute room floor.

2. Do not leave garbage in your parking spot. There are garbage bins at the entrance to the elevator vestibules, on all 3 parking levels.

- StopDisaster. This iPhone app walks you through preparedness checklists for hurricanes, earthquakes, blizzards and other disasters.
- Dropbox. Install the program on your PC or Mac, upload files to your folder, and they are instantly available on all your other computers.
- MotionX GPS Drive. MotionX GPS Drive is the cheapest and most popular way to guide you out of town on an unfamiliar route.
- Flashlight by Rik for iPhone and Brightest Flashlight. These apps turn your phones into flashlights.
- Hurricane Tracker. This hurricanetracking app is for serious weather junkies and people who want to be better-informed.
- Life360. The family GPS tracking system can help you find your loved ones anywhere.
- 5-0 Radio Police Scanner Lite Pick up police band radio.
- GasBuddy. Uses your GPS to display up-to-the-minute gas prices near you, so you can avoid price gouging.
- Hands-Only CPR. App walks you through the two-step checklist: call 911, start chest compressions.

How to peel a tomato. Culinary authority John Leonard says the best way to peel a tomato is: Put it into boiling water for 10 seconds, then transfer it to cold water and peel off the skin.

Want the seeds removed? Leonard, author of Yum! Irresistible, Fun-to-Create, Reliable Recipes (Heron Hill Press) says: Cut the tomato through the middle and squeeze each half of it to press out the seeds. If some remain, scrape them out with a spoon.

- Speed-dust at eye level. Microfiber picks up dirt like nobody's business. Grab a microfiber cleaner for a quick "dust-busting" of your bookshelves, lamp shades and coffee tables.
- Make countertops sparkle. Spritz kitchen and bathroom counters with a freshly scented all-purpose cleaner and quickly wipe away spots, crumbs and everyday grime.


