#### Email for Mass Distribution List for Offsite Owners

We are creating a mass email distribution list so that all owners including offsite owners, may be kept up to date regarding upcoming service work, newsletters and other items of importance. Next time you pass the Concierge desk, please ensure that we have your email address.

#### **Owner Information**

There are times when the Corporation needs to contact the owner in writing: Some examples are the AGM, Annual Budget and Maintenance fees or even private concerns regarding the suite. These are not sent via email. It is extremely important that the Corporation have a current mailing address for the owner. Our records are only updated from information using the Owner Information Form provided by the owner himself. Owners must contact the office for a form when changing: address, tenants (if renting), email, new phone number, designating a third party to act on your behalf, etc. If there have been changes in the past 1 year, please contact the office immediately to request a form be sent to you.

#### **Boardroom Agreement**

Resident's can now bring, non-alcoholic beverages, light fare (sandwiches, pizza, etc) and finger food to their meetings in the Boardroom. A non-refundable cleaning fee of \$25 is charged.

#### **Clogged Dryer Vents Cause Fires**

Lint caught in the dryer and dryer vent, reduces the airflow and creates a highly flammable fuel source. Clothes dryer fires account for about 15,600 fires, 15 deaths, and 400 injuries annually. Owners must ensure that the dryer vent and lint trap is cleaned annually.
